Presented to
Aloha Council, Boy Scouts of America

WHEREAS, in 1916, Alatan Wilder of Troop 5, "Queen Lili'uokalani's Own Troop," became Hawai'i's first Eagle Scout; and

WHEREAS, in 2015, Justice Kanaulu of Troop 100, "Go For Broke" Association, became Hawai'i's 10,000th Eagle Scout and represents all Eagle Scouts past, present and future; and

WHEREAS, Eagle Scouts have collectively contributed over the last century to the cultural and economic fabric of this great state; and

WHEREAS, in 2014, 229 Aloha Council Boy Scouts achieved the highest rank of Eagle Scout and gave 18,000 hours of service back to Hawai'i's communities through Eagle Projects; and

WHEREAS, Aloha Council, Boy Scouts of America promotes courage, confidence and character in young men, training them to serve their communities and make the world a better place;

THEREFORE I, DAVID Y. IGE, Governor, and I, SHAN S. TSUTSUI, Lieutenant Governor of the State of Hawai'i, do hereby proclaim May 1, 2015 as

"10,000TH EAGLE SCOUT MILESTONE DAY"

in Hawai'i and encourage the citizens of the Aloha State to recognize the positive contributions that the Aloha Council, Boy Scouts of America has made to our communities.
