

"Addition to Kahului Airport, Parts 1 and 2," Part 1 containing an area of 10.157 acres, and Part 2 containing an area of 12.455 acres, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 25,259 and dated February 25, 2013, and

"Addition to Kahului Airport, Part 3," containing an area of 55.477 acres, more particularly described in Exhibit "C" and delineated on Exhibit "D," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 25,260 and dated February 25, 2013.

SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to the condition that upon cancellation of this executive order or in the event of non-use or abandonment of the premises or any portion thereof for a continuous period of one (1) year, or for any reason whatsoever, the State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation, shall, within a reasonable time, restore the premises to a condition satisfactory and acceptable to the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii.

SUBJECT, FURTHER, to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.

This executive order does not authorize the recipient of the set aside to sell or exchange or otherwise relinquish the State of Hawaii's title to the subject public land.

The State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation (DOT), as the airport sponsor, is subject to the Federal Aviation Administration's (FAA) Grant Assurances with the State of Hawaii as a condition of receiving continued funding through the Airport Improvement Program to operate and maintain the airport system, and must comply with the guidelines provided in the FAA's Airport Compliance Manual (Order 5190.6B), as amended. As such, the DOT cannot dispose any part of its title or interests in the property without first receiving approval by the FAA. In addition, DOT cannot dispose of any part of the title or interest in the property without approval from the Board of Land and Natural

Resources and complying with applicable laws.

PARTS 1 AND 2

Kahului, Wailuku, Maui, Hawaii

PART 1: Being a portion of Grant 3343 to Claus Spreckels conveyed to the State of Hawaii by Old Stable, LLC by deed dated August 29, 2012 and recorded as Document No. A-46260233.

Being also all of Lots 21-B, 21-C and 21-D of E Paepae Ka Puko'a Subdivision.

Beginning at the east corner of this parcel of land and on the northwest side of Paia Spur, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "PUU NENE 2" being 1794.93 feet North and 7148.40 feet West, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 71° 33' 714.86 feet along the northwest side of Paia Spur;
2. 161° 33' 613.67 feet along Part 2 of Addition to Kahului Airport;
3. 250° 42' 38" 714.94 feet along Kahului Airport, Governor's Executive Order 2346;
4. 341° 33' 624.15 feet along Lot 21-A of E Paepae Ka Puko'a Subdivision to the point of beginning and containing an AREA OF 10.157 ACRES.

Being also all of Lots 21-E, 21-F and 21-G of E Paepae Ka Puko'a Subdivision.

Beginning at the south corner of this parcel of land and at the northwest corner of Paia Spur, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "PUU NENE 2" being 1290.14 feet North and 8661.45 feet West, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 158° 59' 600.98 feet along Kahului Airport, Parcel A of Governor's Executive Order 2427;
2. 250° 42' 38" 907.18 feet along Kahului Airport, Governor's Executive Order 2346;
3. 341° 33' 613.67 feet along Part 1 of Addition to Kahului Airport;
4. 71° 33' 880.17 feet along the northwest side of Paia Spur to the point of beginning and containing an AREA OF 12.455 ACRES.
