The Lions Club of Honolulu

WHEREAS, the Lions Club of Honolulu Foundation, Incorporated, is organized to fulfill scientific, educational and charitable purposes; and to enhance the work of charitable organizations in the communities of Honolulu; and

WHEREAS, the Lions Club of Honolulu is celebrating 90 years of its existence as a benevolent organization;

THEREFORE I, DAVID Y. IGE, Governor, and I, SHAN S. TSUTSUI, Lieutenant Governor of the State of Hawai'i, do hereby proclaim October 11, 2016 as
