

WHEREAS, the Board of Land and Natural Resources at its meeting of February 13, 2015, approved the withdrawal of portions of the Government Land of Waiohue and Nakapehu from the Koolau Forest Reserve.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DAVID Y. IGE, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Section 183-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, do hereby order that the following described land, identified as "Withdrawal Portions of Koolau Forest Reserve, Governor's Proclamation dated August 24, 1905 and June 12, 1907 as modified by Governor's Proclamation dated May 2, 1938, Parts 1 and 2," situate at Waiohue and Nakapehu, Koolau, Maui, Hawaii, Part 1 being a portion of the Government Land of Nakapehu, containing an area of 0.241 acre, and Part 2 being portions of the Government Land of Waiohue and Nakapehu, containing an area of 1.471 acres, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, being designated as C.S.F. No. 25,532 and dated August 9, 2016, is hereby withdrawn from the Operation Governor's Proclamation dated August 24, 1905 and June 12, 1907 as modified by Governor's Proclamation dated May 2, 1938,

SUBJECT to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.


