



Proclamation

WHEREAS, the Hawaii State Bar Association (HSBA) unites and inspires Hawai'i's lawyers by promoting justice, serving the public, and improving the legal profession; and

WHEREAS, as part of the HSBA's effort, the Young Lawyers Division (YLD) of the HSBA is promoting this year's Law Week program; and

WHEREAS, the YLD is coordinating and conducting Action Line telethons on KHON2 News that will cover bankruptcy; landlord tenant; traffic court and motor vehicle citations; trusts, estates and probate; and family law; and

WHEREAS, the YLD is offering free legal clinics to the public on Kaua'i, Oahu, Maui, and Hawai'i Island on a wide variety of topics including elder care, estate planning, child custody, divorce and employment law; and

WHEREAS, the clinics will provide pro bono legal services to the community by providing free legal information and referrals to other nonprofit legal organizations; and

WHEREAS, volunteer lawyers will be at the clinics to help educate the public about various areas of law and share free legal information with those who attend;

THEREFORE I, DAVID Y. IGE, Governor, and I, JOSHUA B. GREEN, Lieutenant Governor of the State of Hawai'i, do hereby proclaim May 6-12, 2019 as

in Hawai'i and ask the people of the Aloha State to join us in recognizing the HSBA and the YLD for their commitment to improving the legal profession and highlighting the important role of attorneys, judges, and other legal professionals in our community.
