

FY25 Budget: Delivering For Hawai'i

\$10.4B

Building Affordable Housing Investing in Climate Resilience Expanding Hawai'i's Economy \$196.1M

appropriated for Maui wildfire recovery in FY25 (of \$400M total in SB3068)

- ✓ Incentivizes Kama'āina to return home and stimulates our economy

 - Ensure Hawai'i's claims resolution process and future fund for climate-related disasters is stable and fair
 - Model disaster risk and determine sustainable funding path in the future
- Led by Chris Benjamin, co-chair of the Climate Coalition, with stakeholders
- Support efforts to develop comprehensive policies for the next legislative session





Safeguarding Hawai'i and its future




- Threat from natural disasters, including Maui wildfires, have created instabilities in housing and insurance markets
