Wildfires Are Preventable

- Over 98% of wildfires in Hawai'i are human-caused
 - Many are due to campfires, open flames, improper cigarette disposal, or equipment malfunctions

Prevention Starts With Us

- Create defensible spaces around homes
- Have thought-out evacuation plans
- Participate in community-wide preparedness initiatives


Wildfire Risk Preparedness

- Approved 40 RAWS (Remote Automatic Weather Stations)
- New beta sensors with 24-hour alerting capabilities, detecting fires beforehand
- Collaboration with federal partners, nonprofit organizations (HWMO), and our communities for future resilience
- Revamped Siren Protocols
- Reestablished State Fire Marshal



Managing Maui Recovery Costs


\$362M for Maui wildfire relief for FY24
