


Gov. Green Signs Largest Income Tax Cut in State History

### The Green Affordability Plan (GAP)

- ✓ GAP II will build on our GAP I progress
  - ✓ Greatly expanded the dependent tax credit
  - ✓ Doubled EITC and food excise tax credit



- ✓ HB2404: largest tax cut for working families in state history
- ✓ SB1035: GET exemption on certain medical services (Medicare, Medicaid, TRICARE)

#### A Partnership with the Legislature, GAP II will Provide Historic Tax Relief

DE OF HAMPING

- ✓ Greatly increases the standard deduction and indexes tax-brackets to inflation
- ✓ Take-home pay will increase for working families by thousands of dollars a year





✓ High-income taxpayers will pay a larger share of the state's income tax


# SB1035: GET Exemptions on Medical Care
