
Governor Green Signs Bills for Conservation, Environmental Stewardship, and Resources Bills to Protect and Manage Hawai'i's Natural Resources

I. SB 3364: Transforming Hawai'i's Approach to Sustainable and Regenerative Tourism



 Establishes destination management action plans for sustainable and regenerative tourism

Amends the Hawai'i Tourism Authority's (HTA) mandate to emphasize strategic tourism management, regenerative tourism, and Native Hawaiian culture



II. HB 2248: North Shore Beach Management



\$111 to develop a North Shore Beach Management plan, with UH Sea Grant Program

- Develops beach management plan for O'ahu's north shore
- Will include community input and address erosion, recreational access, and natural preservation
 Encompasses long- and short-term planning, public access, nourishment, and innovative adaptation methods





III. Regulating Unsafe and Hazardous Ocean Commercial Activity HB 2475: Regulation of Commercial SB 2575: Prohibition on Seabed **Ocean Activities**

- Addresses unpermitted commercial ocean operators and social media for unauthorized activities
- Provides grounds for enforcement against illegal operators



Mining in State Waters

- Outlaws seabed mining in state marine waters, due to environmental risks and constitutional right to a clean and healthy environment
- Prohibits permits for seabed mining activities and associated infrastructure in state marine waters
