
Governor Green Signs Bills for Public Safety and Crime Prevention

Bills to Protect Our Residents and Communities

I. SB 2845: Strengthening Gun Safety Laws



- ✓ Aligns minimum ammunition age with firearm age of 21
- ✓ Prohibits sale and ownership of ammunition to anyone under 21
- ✓ Specific exemptions for hunting and target shooting activities
- ✓ Sellers must verify the buyer's age through ID





II. SB 2197: Expanding Protections Against Illegal Gambling Activity

- Expands definition of illegal "advance gambling activity" to include owners and operators of illegal gambling houses
- ✓ Individuals who solicit participants, create or establish games and illegal houses, and manage financial activities are included





III. SB 2601: Increasing Statute of Limitations

to Protect our Keiki

- ✓ Extends the time period to initiate civil actions for childhood sexual abuse
- ✓ Allows survivors more time to seek justice
- ✓ Allows courts to order personnel of legal entities against whom claims are brought to undergo training on trauma-informed responses





IV. HB 2231: Expands the State's Goal of Women Officers in Law Enforcement



- ✓ Sets statewide goal to increase the representation of female law enforcement officers to 30% by 2030
- ✓ Includes nonbinary officers in Law Enforcement
- ✓ Requires law enforcement agencies to recruit officers from diverse backgrounds, including diverse educational backgrounds
