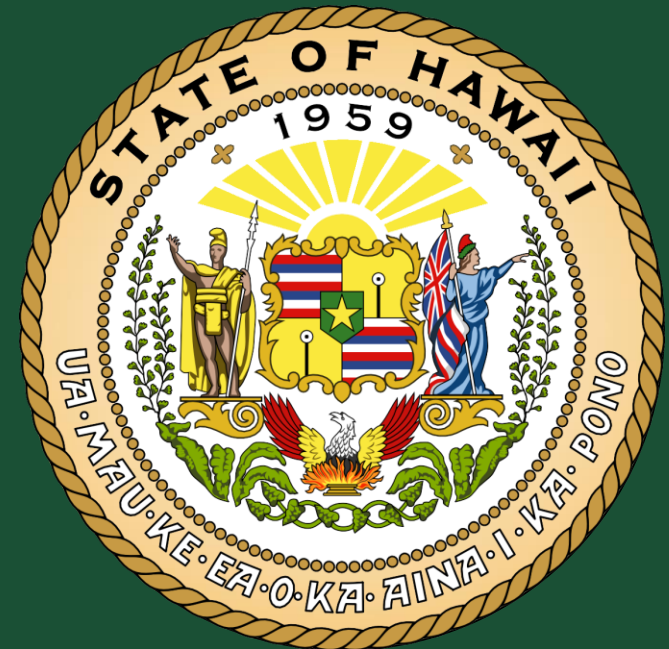

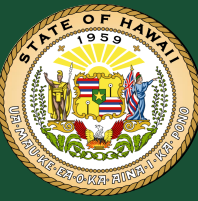

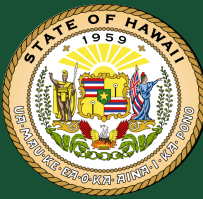

FY25 Budget: Delivering For Hawai'i

\$10.3B Over \$200M

in General Appropriations
for FY 25 (HB1800)

Appropriated for Maui wildfire
recovery's Major Disaster Fund

\$230M in G.O. bonds for rental housing

\$136.4M for Hawai'i's healthcare priorities

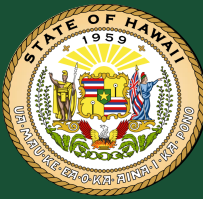
\$33M appropriated for Kauhale communities

HB2404 is Historic Income Tax Reform

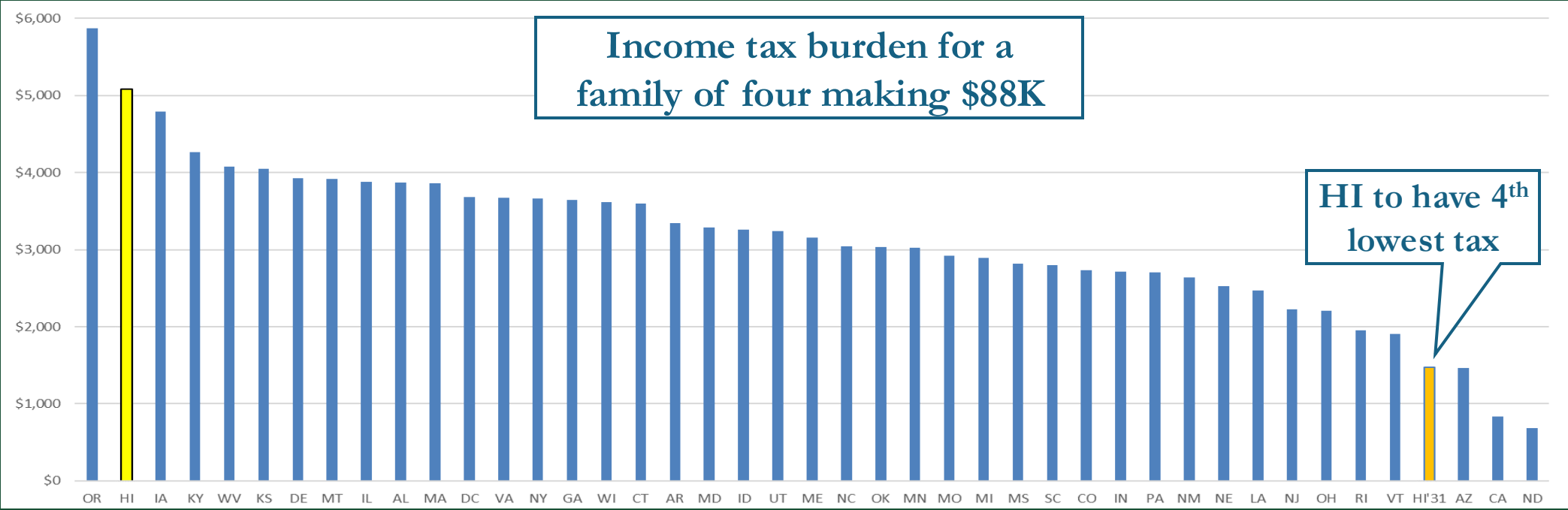

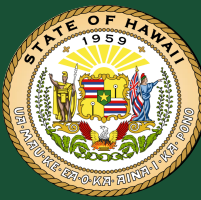

By 2031, ~40% of taxpayers will pay **ZERO** state income tax



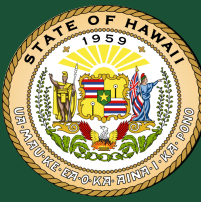


A Partnership with the Legislature, GAP II will Provide Historic Tax Relief

✓ Greatly increases the standard deduction and indexes tax-brackets to inflation

✓ Take-home pay will increase for working families by thousands of dollars a year

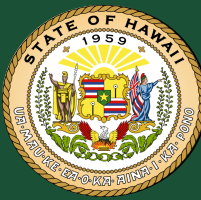


I. Affordable Housing and Homelessness

- ✓ SB 2919: Short-term rental bill
- ✓ HB 2685 and 2801: Solar Hui Program and C-PACER program to Hawai'i Green Infrastructure Authority for Condo Owners
- ✓ Continued Affordable Housing and kauhale Development (\$33M appropriated)
- ✓ \$5M for Hawai'i Community Development Authority and \$10.5M in for the Hawaii Public Housing Authority



HHFDC's Ililani Condominiums, with 197 affordable units, opened on May 17, 2024.



II. Investing in Healthcare

- ✓ SB3139: Establishing Emergency Crisis Intervention and Diversion Services Program
- ✓ HB2159: Empowering State Assistance for Assisted Community Treatment Cases
- ✓ HB1827: \$6.8M in public-private partnerships for Healthcare Workforce Development
- ✓ SB1035: GET Exemptions on Medical Care



III. Preserving our 'Āina for future generations



- ✓ Agreement with Hawai'i youth on a statewide DOT greenhouse gas emissions reduction plan
- ✓ SB2575: Prohibition on Seabed Mining in State Waters
- ✓ HB2475: Regulation of Unpermitted Commercial Ocean Activities
- ✓ \$21.3 million for ecosystem protection and restoration and \$24.7 million for natural area reserves and watershed management

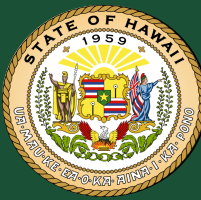


IV. Investing in our Keiki and Hawai'i's Future



- ✓ HB2430: Establishing Hawai'i's commitment to Summer EBT for Keiki (\$2.1M state commitment)
- ✓ SB2475: Harm to Student Registry
- ✓ HB2074: \$3.5M investment in Hawaiian language immersion education in Hawai'i's Kaiapuni schools
- ✓ Signed Act 172, SLH 2023 to build and develop affordable teacher housing
- ✓ \$20.9M for summer learning hubs





V. Healing and Resilience for Maui

- ✓ No more individuals in NCS, 100% full transition into longer term housing for affected families
- ✓ 88% of debris cleared from residential lots — permits open
- ✓ Building 1,044 units for transition
- ✓ SB2085: Creating State Fire Marshal
- ✓ HB2107: HI-EMA Language Access Coordinator for limited-English proficiency communities
- ✓ Over \$200M appropriated for Maui Recovery in the Major Disaster Fund



Key Updates: FestPAC and Senate District 22



Hawai'i Hosts FestPAC for the first time

- ✓ Ho'oulu Lāhui: Regenerating Oceania
- ✓ Over 2,200 delegates



Hawai'i State Senate District 22 Vacancy

- ✓ Balancing constitutional duty with obligation for free and fair elections
- ✓ Will respect the will of the district's voters
