




SB 1396: A Climate Resilience & Hazard Mitigation Solution



- In 2024, we established the Climate Advisory Team (CAT) to develop policies for climate and hazard resilience.
- The CAT identified the need for dedicated funding to support climate disaster prevention and mitigation efforts.
- Governor Green pushed to establish a Green Fee and introduced SB 1396.



The Green Fee: Dedicated Funding for Climate Resilience



- First legislation of its kind in the nation.
- Funds climate resilience and economic development while minimizing burden to local residents.
- Collaboration with the tourism industry to protect our natural resources.
- Expected to generate \$100M annually.



The Green Fee: Funding Resiliency Through the TAT



- Increases the Transient
 Accommodations Tax (TAT) by 0.75%
 - > Includes TAT on cruise ships
- * Revenues will fund environmental conservation, climate resilience and sustainable tourism.



Funding Our Future



- Environmental stewardship
 - Protect land and aquatic resources, preserve native flora and fauna
- Climate and hazard resiliency
 - ➤ Harden infrastructure, mitigate wildfire and flood risks
- Sustainable tourism
 - Destination management, beach nourishment, park improvements
