Background and Summary

Applicant Background	Founded in 2004 the Hawaii Family Law Clinic dba Ala Kuola hereinafter Ala Kuola, was established to help victims of domestic violence with completion and filing of Petitions For A Temporary Restraining Order with the Family Court of the First Circuit. Ala Kuola also provided follow up services and provided referral legal assistance and other services. Throughout the years as domestic violence together with incidents of sexual assault and its consequent problems have become more prevalent throughout the State of Hawaii. This has led Ala Kuola since 2014 to undertake a positive proactive role by providing a youth prevention program based on an existing nationally and internationally evidence-based program known as Coaching Boys Into Men (CBIM). It also be noted that Ala Kuola will also be introducing a program for girls based on the evidence-based platform of CBIM. Since engaging with CBIM in many communities statewide, Ala Kuola has trained numerous athletic coaches to deliver the curriculum to youth. The training is provided by a trainer that is certified by Futures Without Violence the creator for CBIM.		
Funding Request Purpose	A one year goal for the duration of this grant is recruit and conduct male and female coaches/facilitators statewide to participate with Coaching Boys Into Men and Leaders for Change. Conduct trainings with coaches/facilitators with the use of the curriculum to effectively deliver to youth; Provide athletic coaches/facilitators with resources needed to promote respectful behaviors among their peers and help prevent relationship abuse, bullying, harassment and sexual assault. Objective: Train approximately 20 - 30 coaches/facilitators both men and women to be trained with the curriculum of Coaching Boys Into Men and Leaders for Change. Have approximately 500 -1000 youth receive training of the curriculum of Coaching Boys Into Men and Leaders for Change. Approximately 20 coaches/facilitators will fully implement the programs.		
Geographic Coverage Served	The programs will be offered throughout the state to all communities.		

Public Purpose or Need Served	The public purpose of Coaching Boys Into Men and Leaders For Change is reduce relationship abuse, sexual assault and to promote respectful behaviors. Dating violence can be physical, emotional, psychological, or sexual . It is a prevalent issue that has serious long-term and short term effects. Many teen do not report it because they are afraid to tell friends or family or even their school administrators. It was reported by the Center for Disease Control, that amount of women and men first experience some form of partner violence between 11 and 17 years of age. Further, approximately 9% of high school students report being hit, slapped, or physically hurt on purpose by a boyfriend or girlfriend. Those who experience dating violence can suffer negative effects in health throughout their lifetime. Youth victims are more likely to experience symptoms of depression and anxiety, engage in unhealthy behaviors, like tobacco, drugs, alcohol, or exhibit behaviors or think about suicide. According to the Center for Disease Control , CDC's Youth Risk Behavior Surveillance System (YRBSS) issues such as having to be forced to have intercourse, experience sexual violence ,electronically bullied, experiencing sexual dating violence , bullied on school property experienced physical dating violence are prevalent issues that you individual encounter. By no means is this an exhaustive list of behaviors that are experienced.
Target Population Served	The target population is male and females adolescents and youth.

Projected Annual Timeline	Quarter 1,2,3 - Recruitment of Coaches/facilitators and training with the use of the curriculum . Provide to coaches/facilitator distribution of opt out forms to parents/ guardians. Coaches/facilitators provide surveys via hard copy or QR code. Retrieval of administered survey to be analyzed by Ala Kuola staff. Ala Kuola will throughout implementation to provide any technical assistance , monitor engagement and have available in open line of communication. Quarter 4, Will be similar to quarter 1,2,&3, however Ala Kuola will gather data from a post surveys upon conclusion of the delivery of the curriculum.. Note that some coaches/facilitator may concluded delivery of the program at different intervals. A final report will be provided to the administering agency together with final expenditures. Quality Assurance and Evaluation Plans	Ala Kuola utilizes unidentifiable surveys of both coaches/facilitators and program participants. The data collected through the surveys will be analyzed synthesized by Ala Kuola in determining learning outcomes of the curriculum delivered to participants. This Data will also be used to to determine to make programmatic changes. Ala Kuola conducts periodic check-ins with coaches/facilitator to ensure that they are support with any technical advice concerning the curriculum or the delivery of the program.
Scope of Work	In implementing the curriculum for Coaching Boys Into Men or Leaders for Change, Ala Kuola will act as the guide, leader and trainer in providing coaches and community participants with the tools and training they will require to successfully implement the program they will be engaging in. Training provided will be either in a group setting or on a one to one basis. Training may occur on the neighbor island or remotely when practice. Training may consist of inter-active role play , identifying abusive behaviors and suggested strategies to implement the program in their communities. Since Coaching Boys Into Men was created. for male high school athletes the curriculum can be deliver through an adaptation for adolescents as well. The adaptation for Leaders for Change for females will be base on the platform of the evidence-base curriculum of CBIM. The training with the use of the curriculum will be delivered with staff/consultants of Ala Kuola who have extensive experience working with the curriculum. Coaches /facilitators will provided with all materials and containing the curriculum and will be provided a solid foundation to implement the program. once per week. The materials provided offer strategies about opening the conversation about dating violence as well as techniques for helping participants develop appropriate and healthy relationships toward women and girls as will as their peers. A Training topics consist of ,respect and personal responsibility , mental health matters, insulting language, disrespectful behaviors toward women and girls, digital disrespect, understanding consent Part 1, understanding consent part 2, bragging about sexual reputation, when aggression crosses the line, taking a stand against relationship abuse, conflict and communication, make pledge for respect and equity. Again, please note that the curriculum will be presented via adaptation for younger participant. Although the presentation to participants are intended to be brief (approximately 15-20 minutes per week), it is the consistency of the message and the repeated weekly lessons that will make the greatest impact. Although the curriculum provides the talking points to be address coaches /participants are encouraged draw up analogies of current events and past events as it relates to the discussion.

Due to privacy matters when administering the program with public schools Ala Kuola continues to enter into a Data Sharing Agreement with the Hawaii Department of Education Data Governance office. This Agreement allows Ala Kuola to conduct unidentifiable surveys form and further allows parents or legal guardians the opportunity to opt out of the program. This is extremely important since recent US Supreme court decisions have addressed the issues of opting out their children. The training of all coaches are conducted by Ed Flores who underwent training with Futures Without Violence the creator of the evidence-base curriculum and as result is a certified trainer with the curriculum. He has been recognized for the positive results and engagement of the program throughout the state and serves as a member with the Coaching Boys Into Men National Advisory Council.
