Dear Governor Green:

Thank you for your October 29, 2025, letter regarding Army training lands in Hawai'i. I appreciate your engagement on this critical national security matter and the cooperation between our teams to work towards a mutually acceptable agreement.

I fully support convening a joint negotiation team. LTG Vowell will be the Army's senior representative in these negotiations. I will also ask a few members of my team from the Department of the Army Headquarters to participate in these discussions. I recommend the negotiation team work to identify the best co-chairs of the technical working group.

We are working to identify and request funds through the Federal budget process to support Army community benefits in Hawai'i. I would ask that the State of Hawai'i continue to engage agencies outside of the Department of War on their potential investments in Hawai'i.

Thank you for your support in this effort. I look forward to a follow-up bilateral meeting between our offices to finalize an agreement.
