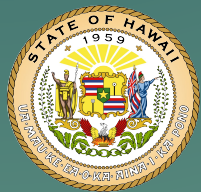

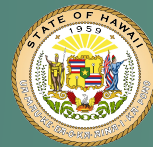

Establishing a Clean Fuel Standard

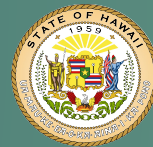


- Requires the Department of Transportation to establish a **statewide Clean Fuel Standard**.
 - Program implementation by Jan. 1, 2028
 - Sets phased carbon-reduction targets — 10% below 2019 levels by 2035.
 - Establishes a credit system that rewards cleaner fuels and assigns deficits to carbon-intensive fuels.



SB 2999

Establishing a Clean Fuel Standard



- **Co-beneficial model:**

- Incentivizes investment and job creation across various sectors.
- Supports local agriculture and renewable energy industries.
- Expands markets for homegrown fuels, including options for turning waste products into energy sources.
- Strengthens public and environmental health and improves air quality.
